Faith Through Fire holds space for men and women to heal emotionally from the trauma of breast cancer. Our vision is to see those diagnosed with breast cancer reclaim their lives so they and their families can be restored. Our Mission is to reduce the fear and anxiety breast cancer patients feel and replace it with hope and a path toward thriving.

BENEFICIARY PROFILE

Patients come to us feeling shock, fear and isolation. A survivor impacted by Faith Through Fire becomes better not bitter and is:

- **Self-aware** knows there is room for personal growth.
- Multi-dimensional- understands they are not a disease but a soul whose needs expand beyond the physical
- **Motivated** resourceful and ready for help.
- **Determined** to restore their lives and to delight in family again to positively impact future generations.
- Resilient- acknowledges breast cancer is difficult but refuses to let it define them.
- Committed- to using their experience to help others.

BI-DIRECTIONAL IMPACT

Frequently survivors volunteer to mentor because they want to alleviate the emotional suffering felt by the newly diagnosed. What they don't anticipate is in doing so, they bring purpose and healing to their own journey- even years after diagnosis.





FUTURE FOCUS

All patients who come to us show symptoms of being traumatized. However, mental health often takes a backseat in the treatment process. This is what makes our work so important. In 2023 Faith Through Fire has two aims— to reduce distress and provide a path toward post–traumatic growth. With your help we intend to:

- Provide more personalized care to our beneficiaries via a custom intake form to identify their current mental state, needs, expectations for the program and existing support systems.
- Provide trauma education to both oncology providers and breast cancer patients to improve whole-person care and empower patients to prioritize their mental health during and after treatment.
- Develop meaningful outcomes and measurement tools that can effectively show our impact.
- Provide more support to men diagnosed with breast cancer via recruitment of more male survivor mentors.
- Identify how we can further prioritize our incurable members by surrounding them with a caring and dependable network of support.
